- 1. Welcome, introductions (Sierra)
 - Welcome new immunization coordinator, Andrea Kauffman! She will be phasing in as the new cochair of BCIC in the coming months.
- 2. Health Department flu drive (Harold)
 - Flu drive was earlier this year (all drives in September)
 - There was some group discussion around the timing of these drives, as the ideal time of vaccination has been said to be at the end of October/Early November. Health Department may have pushed them earlier to improve numbers from last year.
 - Over 1,500 attendees across 3 flu drives in Bucks County
- 3. Fall conference updates (Maria and Sierra)
 - Eventbrite registration
 - We have 33 registrants, hoping to attract nursing students from area colleges. Maria,
 Lynne and Sierra are going to reach out this week.
 - There was group discussion around why registration may be low for this event: thinking late promotion, fee and difficulties having employer pay could be contributors
 - Group agreed we will aim for 1 conference per year and focus on a fall dinner conference for October 2020 at Bucks County Community College and offer nursing CEs and Act 48. Lynne is going to help find a lead on getting Act 48. Eileen will work on securing space at BCCC.

 - Group came to the consensus that we will aim for a fall 2020 dinner conference instead since dinners seem to be more well-attended
