



Prevent Disease – Get Immunized!

Pennsylvania School Vaccination Requirements

Each child, K-12 must be immunized by the **first day** of school and/or have a valid medical certificate, or your school-aged child will not be allowed in school.

Diphtheria, tetanus, and acellular pertussis (Usually given as DTaP, DTP, DT, or Td) 1 dose on or after 4th birthday)	4 doses	4 doses	4 doses
Polio 4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given	4 doses A 4th dose is not necessary if the 3rd dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose	4 doses A 4th dose is not necessary if the 3rd dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose	4 doses A 4th dose is not necessary if the 3rd dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (Usually given as MMR)	2 doses	2 doses	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses	3 doses	3 doses
Varicella (chickenpox)	2 doses or evidence of immunity	2 doses or evidence of immunity	2 doses or evidence of immunity
Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)	Not applicable	1 dose	1 dose
Meningococcal Conjugate (MenACWY)	Not applicable	1 dose	2 doses A 2nd dose of MenACWY is not necessary if the 1st dose was given at age 16 years of age or older
